## Readiness, Respect, and Responsibility

These three R's are part of a pledge that Radloff students recite every morning to ensure that they are doing their part in getting the best education possible. Our management plan is designed to reinforce positive behaviors and to discourage negative behaviors. Our primary expectation is that a student's behavior will not disrupt the learning process. We have found that students who are prepared for class, actively engaged in learning, and respectful of others rarely have behavior issues.

Each week, parents will receive an update regarding academic grades and student behavior on the **Dail & Price Weekly Progress Report**. Academic progress can be accessed through the parent portal or student's – my e-class. The weekly report will list the problem behavior, date & time, and the consequence that was given.
